Course Format

Each class session will have a mixture of lecture topics, lab sessions consisting of guided exercises and programming examples.

Participation in class and lab exercises is strongly encouraged by taking attendance, giving quizzes and lab submissions at the end of the week. Programming together and group discussions are encouraged. Three weekly drops for attendance and lab submission are allowed without medical excuse.

There will be approximately one short quiz per week. For each week, the Tuesday and Thursday labs can be submitted at the end of class on Thursday, or if more work needs to be done to finish the lab, the lab sheets can be submitted at any time up to the beginning of class on the Tuesday of next week. Lab sheets can be submitted at the Student Services office on the first floor or at the office in 245 on the second floor of Hinds Hall.

The three homework assignments are to be individual work. Discussion of ideas for the assignment is fine, but the program submitted must be your own work and copying will be heavily penalized. The final project is a group project that will have a class presentation as well as a project submission.

The three exams are entirely individual. The exams are “closed book” with no materials allowed, except that for Exam 2 and the Final Exam, you may bring your own prepared notes, with a limited number of sheets.
