

Radio Buttons and Check Boxes

After you place a set of Radio Buttons or Check Boxes on a form, the code to find out if one has been checked is the same:

If RadioButton1.checked

If Checkbox1.checked

You can also use something like

If checkbox1.checked = true

The difference between Radio Buttons and Check Boxes is that only one radio button can be checked at a time, but any number of check boxes can be checked.

Memo Boxes

Memo Boxes are good for writing multiple lines to the screen. To set up a memo box, you need to do the following:

- Put one on the form.
- Double click on the *strings...* in the property *lines*. By default the memo box only has 2 lines.
- You must manually add lines by hitting the return key in the String List Editor window that appears when you double click on the *strings...*

A line in a memo box is referenced as follows:

Memo1.lines[x]

where *x* is any integer or integer variable.

Memo boxes start at line 0.
